Suitable for interior & exterior use.

TYPES OF SUBSTRATE

Interior and exterior bare timber with knots, doors, door frames, furniture and railings.

COVERAGE



Woodworks Teak Oil will cover approximately 15-20sqm per litre, depending on the nature and porosity of the timber.

DRYING TIME



Product will be dry / recoatable after 12 hours at room temperature.

TRANSPORTATION & STORAGE

To avoid the risk of spillage, always store and transport in a secure, upright position.

STORE AWAY FROM HEAT, FLAME AND SOURCES OF IGNITION.

CLEANER

Methylated Spirit.

VOC CONTENT

HIGH VOC CONTENT 25-50% VOCs (Volatile Organic Compounds) contribute to atmospheric pollution.

PREPARATION

Ensure that the wood to be treated is thoroughly clean, dry, and free from resinous matter or loose particles. Clean oily timber with White Spirit. Rub down the surface with abrasive paper to provide a key. Avoid the inhalation of dust. Wear a suitable face mask if dry sanding. APPLICATION



Apply Woodworks Teak Oil liberally by using a cloth or brush. Remove excess Linseed Oil after 10-15 minutes with a clean cloth. Up to 3 coats may be required for bare timber, rubbing previous coat with fine sandpaper for a key; use 1 coat for maintenance of existing coating.

CLEANING



Remove as much product as possible from application equipment before cleaning. Clean equipment immediately after use in White Spirit or Turpentine Substitute. Replace lid firmly. Some local authorities have special facilities for the disposal of waste coatings. Do not empty product into drains or watercourses.

PRECAUTIONS

- Flammable liquid and vapour.
- May be fatal if swallowed and enters airways.
- Hazardous ingredients: Naphtha (petroleum) hydrotreated heavy:Nota(s) P
- Safety data sheet available on request.
- Repeated exposure may cause skin dryness or cracking.
- Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames and other ignition sources. No smoking.

- IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of water. Do not use solvent thinners or White Spirit.
- IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTRE or doctor.
 Do NOT induce vomiting.
- Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep cool.
- Store locked up.
